When connecting the Apple personal computer using Macintosh OS X Leopard software to a Microsoft Windows 2003 server, we need to make a modification, so individuals can see their folder when logging onto the server.

On the Apple personal computer, we need to log in to the machine as the administrator. Click on the apple at the upper left hand corner of the monitor and select System Preferences as shown in figure 1.
